Scientific Rationale

Scientific research and the ever-increasing interest of industry have undoubtedly contributed to the establishment and diffusion of endoluminal techniques for the treatment of all areas within our interest, as carotid artery disease, aortic disease, and peripheral arterial disease.

Specifically for the aortic region, new technologies allow vascular surgeons to treat also pathologies involving the aortic arch, the boundary between open surgery, performed by cardiac surgeons, and endovascular surgery, performed by vascular surgeons.

We have structured our scientific event into a series of sessions, to ensure discussion among experts and scientific updates on both surgical and endovascular techniques related to the main areas of our expertise.

The first session will be dedicated to an update on both surgical and endovascular techniques about carotid artery diseases, according to the most recent guidelines.

The second and third sessions of the first day will be dedicated to aortic diseases, from the aortic arch to the infrarenal abdominal aorta, focusing in particular on the most recent and innovative endovascular techniques that allow us to treat highly complex pathologies, reducing mortality and morbidity rates.

The second day is dedicated to the peripheral arterial disease and to complex vascular access for hemodialysis, reporting the most recent results in the current literature on available drug-eluting balloons and stents.

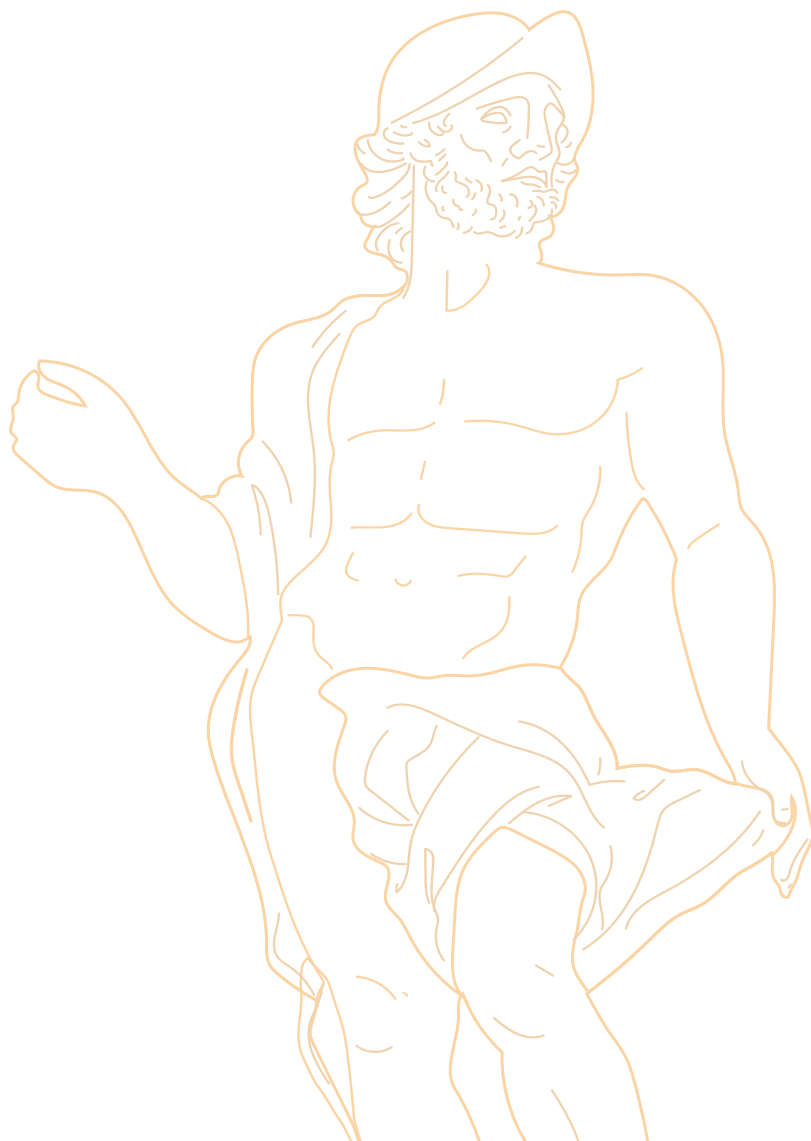
We also strongly believe in the importance of young surgeons, so we have organized two poster sessions to encourage discussion of complex clinical cases.
